## CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

**This Code of Conduct Policy applies to all:  
PLAYER, PARENT/ GUARDIAN'S, and EXTENDED FAMILY**

Adherence to the Club's CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY is valid from initial date of registration and continues for the duration of that particular players and/or officials membership.

ALL persons directly affiliated with a specific registered player, albeit a parent, guardian's, extended family, family friend or associate - do agree, when coming to spectate or play, to abide by the club's code of conduct policy.

To ensure children receive the greatest benefit from netball, parents & guardians should, at all times:

- \* **BE SUPPORTIVE** of players, coaches and other officials - and teach and expect your child to do the same.
- \* **VOLUNTEER** to be involved with the club when the call goes out. Our club depends on the involvement of everyone association with the club. We don't ask often, but when we do, we'd really appreciate the help!
- \* **ALWAYS** shout encouragement to your child, their team, and encourage good sportsmanship at all times
- \* **APPLAUD** good game play by both teams
- \* **ACCEPT** all Coach & Umpire decisions, please keep all thoughts about umpires decisions to the non verbal type. Concerns with umpiring are to be address by the Coach. Parents are not to approach the umpire during or after the game regarding umpiring decisions.
- \* **SUPPORT** all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the playing and training arena
- \* **DEAL** with any dispute using the appropriate process, put any unresolved grievance in writing to the Committee of teamSTELLAR Netball Club.
- \* **ACCEPT** all Club Policies
- \* **'FRIEND'** our 'teamSTELLAR Netball Club' Facebook Page to ensure your are kept up to date with all club related information as well our Instagram page
- \* **BE A GREAT ROLE MODEL** - don't be the ugly on the sidelines thats talked about for months afterwards.
- \* **TEACH** your child that an honest effort is as important as a victory
- \* **FOCUS** on your child's efforts and performance rather than the overall outcome of the game/event
- \* **NEVER** ridicule or shout at your child for making a mistake or losing a game
