TEAM SELECTION POLICY



PROCESS

When allocating players into teams, teamSTELLAR focus more on enjoyment of players and less on placing or 'stacking' of teams, to guarantee finals berths.

Our club is all about longevity of players in the sport of netball, and ensuring our players as much as possible, continue to enjoy playing the sport as long as possible. As such, when allocating players to teams, including playing with friends, personalities are put more into account than their physical ability.

We try wherever possible to place or keep friendships together, and place players with coaches who we believe will best suit their ability and personalities.

If the player is new to the club, they will be placed randomly into an age appropriate team.

PLEASE NOTE: teamSTELLAR Netball Club is not adverse to combining age groups (eg. U11/U12), as we feel often times, this improves individual members meeting and getting to know each other, which in turns, increases club morale and sense of ownership and family.

Our Commitment

teamSTELLAR is committed to providing a safe, enjoyable, inclusive environment to maximise individual participation.

The aim of our team selection Policy is to ensure an open and fair process. Allocation will be based on individual feedback from previous coaches, as well as observation from games played the previous season.

What we ask of you

Make yourself familiar with the selection criteria and clarify any concerns with the club prior to trials.

Talk with your coach about any concerns and seek feedback about how to improve your performance.

Allow the club to ensure the inclusion of all registered players in line without vision.
